



During the meeting held on February 20<sup>th</sup>, 2020, the members of the Commission des entraîneurs du Québec approved changes relating to draw procedures for sanctioned tournaments. Since May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020, Tennis Québec is implementing the following changes:

**Separation of players according to their home club**

No separation of players will be made according to their home club. This means that draws will now be completed randomly and that all participants, without exception, may face one another in the first round of any sanctioned tournament.

**Separation of qualified players**

For the main draws of Étapes and Quebec Championships for the indoor and outdoor selection circuits, qualified players will be automatically separated to avoid the possibility of meeting another qualified player in the first round. This separation will be done in order to offer better balanced main draws.
