In some cases, players can obtain an exemption allowing them to take part in tournaments in categories above what is already permitted according to the tables presented here. **Any exemption request can only be presented by a coach** and must be sent by email to Sylvie Giroux, Coach and Athlete Development Director.

Explanatory note

Please note that during the meeting held on February 20th, 2020, the members of the Commission des entraı̂neurs du Québec approved changes relating to eligibility for sanctioned tournaments that apply since May 1st, 2020. The change pertaining to the eligibility for two-star tournaments was implemented in order to limit the upgrading of players to only one age category. The objective is to encourage the participation of less experienced players in our sanctioned tournaments.

Two-star tournaments

Category	Age
U12 Tournaments	10-12 years old
U14 Tournaments	11-14 years old
U16 Tournaments	13-16 years old
U18 Tournaments	15-18 years old

The eligibility to participate in Étapes and Quebec Championships of the indoor and outdoor selection circuits remains unchanged:

Category	Age
U12 Tournaments	10-12 years old
U14 Tournaments	11-14 years old
U16 Tournaments	12-16 years old
U18 Tournaments	13-18 years old

* Please note that from **September 1**st **each year**, the age eligibility for each category is amended as follows:

Category	Age
U12 Tournaments	9-11 years old
U14 Tournaments	10-13 years old
U16 Tournaments	11-15 years old
U18 Tournaments	12-17 years old

This rule is designed to ensure that only the players eligible to participate in the Canadian championships the following year can register to the selection circuit's fall Étapes starting in October.
