



CHANGES TO ROGERS RANKING in 2019



Please note that there are important changes in the International Events Ranking Points effective 1st Jan 2019. Please check the Ranking tables on <http://rogersrankings.ca/#/> to see how they affect you.

Dear Competitor/Parent,

The purpose of this document is to make you aware of the changes in Rogers Rankings for Players across Canada, which will come in effect retroactively as of 1st Jan 2019. As you may be aware Tennis Europe has made changes in their categorization of tournaments and Ranking points in the first Quarter of 2019. The changes being made in Rogers Rankings are outlined in the table below and will bring the Canadian domestic Rankings in line with Tennis Europe and USTA.

The changes made are in regards to international tournaments for which players will get recognition in Rogers Rankings. These are tournaments outside of the regular tour (ATP/WTA/ITF Junior and Transition).

Recognizing Tennis Europe and USTA Junior Events – Tennis Canada will recognize a few select junior tournaments from Tennis Europe and USTA. This means that Canadians playing in these events will get Ranking points on their Junior Rogers Rankings. The events and the ranking points are as follows:
