New Policy – Withdrawal of a Player after the Draw



During its last meeting, the Tennis Québec Executive Board members validated the implementation of a new policy relating to the withdrawal of a player after a draw has been published. This policy mirrors practices already adopted by Tennis Canada and the International Tennis Federation. Should a player withdraw from any sanctioned tournament, with the exception of Étapes and Quebec Championships, the first player on the reserve list will be awarded the place now available. No other modification to the draws will be made, regardless of whether or not a seeded player has withdrawn.

During the Étapes and Quebec Championships, the usual modifications will continue to be implemented and aim to minimize changes made in the draws. Changes will be made according to recognized rules and standards pertaining to late changes to draws, particularly with respect to seeded players, as the draws have already been published at the time of the withdrawal.
