Selection Circuit – Modification to the eligibility for reserve draws



During a meeting held on October 8th, 2020, the members of the Commission des entraı̂neurs du Québec approved changes relating to the eligibility of players for the reserve draws held alongside the Selection Circuit (Étapes and Quebec Championships). Tennis Québec will implement this new rule from February 1st, 2021.

Age of eligibility for the reserve draws

Only the players from the age category of the tournament will be eligible to participate in the reserve draws of the Étapes and Quebec Championships.

A player who has registered for the tournament, but is not eligible to participate in the reserve draw due to the age restrictions, will receive a full refund of the registration fees.

This modification to the rules has unfortunately become necessary due to the increasing difficulty for clubs to have access to a sufficient number of courts to host all the players desiring to take part in the tournaments, especially during the indoor season. In order to avoid having to cancel reserve draws due to an excessive number of participants and a lack of courts, the decision was made to limit the participation to these two (2) star tournaments.

By imposing such age restrictions, Tennis Québec also wants to ensure that more players may be able to compete within their age category, regardless of their level of play or experience.

It is important to specify that this modification will not prevent any player from participating in the Selection Circuit.

^{*} The eligibility of players has been extended to allow players born in 2013 to participate in the **reserve draws of the two fall U12 Étapes**. Indeed, these players cannot participate in the regular 12 and under tournaments. During the year, they have fewer opportunities to earn points to improve their ranking and to qualify for the main draw or the qualifying draw of the fall Étapes.

Players born in 2013 are disadvantaged compared to players born in 2011 and 2012 who can play the reserve draws and accumulate points for the subsequent Étapes.
